

Report from the Faculty Senate Subcommittee on Academic and Student Affairs
Faculty Senate Meeting on February 1, 2019

The Academic and Student Affairs Subcommittee has met 3 times:

- November 5, 2018
- December 5, 2018
- January 25, 2019

At the 11/5/18 meeting, we took up the question of the roles and relationship between Ed Pol and GRC. We were specifically interested in whether parts of each committee could be combined in a synergistic fashion. After consulting R & P and discussing the goals and responsibility of each committee, which was also discussed at the 12/5/18 meeting, it was decided that we could not recommend any changes/combinations of these two committees to the Faculty Senate Executive Committee.
