- 3. contributions to Lehigh's research and pedagogical environment beyond individual classrooms/research projects.

Current Work Process

- ☐ Biweekly Meetings:
 - Strategizing approaches to P&T processes.
 - Consulted Larry Snyder (Provost's Office) and Marci Levine (Lehigh ADVANCE).

Key Outcomes – P&T Standards Review

- ☐ Collected and verified P&T standards across five colleges with deans.
- Plan to identify inconsistencies to propose recommendations.

Key Outcomes – Public-Facing Work

- ☐ Advocating for a holistic, flexible approach for P&T evaluation.
- ☐ Emphasizing public-facing contributions in research, teaching, and service.
- ☐ Reviewed approaches from institutions like Michigan State, Rutgers, and others.
- Developed three potential approaches for integrating public-facing work and shared with FSEC.

Proposed Options for Public-Facing Work in R&P Revision

- ☐ Option 1: Holistic Approach
 - Incorporate holistic language in R&P documents.
 - Example: Acknowledge traditional and non-traditional contributions (e.g., public-facing work).
- ☐ Option 2: Holistic + Detailed Approach
 - Expand Option 1 by adding detailed definitions and examples in R&P.
 - Example: Define public-facing work, its purpose, and applications in research, teaching, and service.

Proposed Options for Public-Facing Work in R&P Revision

- ☐ Option 3: Supplemental Guidance
 - Keep R&P language unchanged but draft a separate document: Context, definitions, and examples of public-facing work.
 - Implementation details for P&T committees.

Combination of Option 1 (general R&P language change) and Option 3 (Implementation guide)
