KEY FACTORS FOR HIGH QUALITY VETERAN SUPPORT AT OTHER SCHOOLS

- FULL TIME VETERAN COUNSELOR ON CAMPUS
- VETERAN WEBPAGE
- CAMPUS VETERAN ORGANIZATION
- IN STATE TUITION EXTENDED FOR ACTIVE DUTY
- VETERAN BUSINESS OUTREACH
- YELLOW RIBBON PROGRAM (ADVERTISED DURING RECRUITMENT)
- VETERANS UPWARD BOUND PROGRAM (UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA)
- HAVE AT LEAST 20 VETERANS ON CAMPUS

VETERANS AND HIGHER EDUCATION

- APPROXIMATELY 20.8 MILLION VETERANS
- 65% OF ALL VETERANS TAKE HIGHER EDUCATION CLASSES (Department of Veteran Affairs)
- OVER 20,000 VETERANS USED EDUCATION BENEFITS IN PA
 - 42% INCREASE IN EDUCATION BENEFIT USE
- ABOUT 180,000 SERVICE MEMBERS LEAVE ACTIVE DUTY EACH YEAR
- VETERANS ARE A DIVERSE POPULATION
 - About 15% are women
 - Represent every religion, many 1st generation, ethnic, and LGBT groups
 - 25% have a disability rating
 - Worked in over 200 occupational specialties

WHAT FACULTY SHOULD KNOW ABOUT TEACHING VETERANS

- CREATIVITY AND SELF EXPRESSION ARE NOT EMPHASIZED IN MILITARY SERVICE
 - Military writing emphasizes bottom line up front, clear concise wording. Average sentence length of 15 words, with only 15 percent of words having more than two syllables. Veterans have little experience with long writing assignments.
 - Faculty should focus on what students should include in a paper or speech, rather than how long it should be.
- ACCOMODATIONS
 - Veterans may request unusual accommodations, such as sitting against a wall or at the back of a classroom.
- TRAINED NOT TO CHALLENGE AUTHORITY. THEY MAY HAVE DIFFICULTY WITH ASSIGNMENTS WHEN EXPECTATIONS ARE NOT CLEARLY STATED.
- ON THE POSITIVE SIDE: MILITARY CONSTANTLY PROVIDED TRAINING AND EDUCATION ON NEW SKILLS-SO VETERANS ARE READY TO BE LIFE-LONG LEARNERS.
