## Fifth Proposed Revision: 1.3.1 In General (General guidance for faculty committees)

Current R&P Text (Note that the proposed revision only applies to the last paragraph of R&P 1.3.1.)

All standing committees must meet at least once each academic year and shall report to the Faculty Senate those activities which are of general importance and consequence. Any voting member of the faculty may address a written statement regarding faculty business to a faculty committee.

## Proposed R&P Text (Additions in **bold red**, deletions are strikethrough)

All standing committees must meet at least once each academic year and shall report to the Faculty Senate those activities which are of general importance and consequence. Any voting member of the faculty may address a written statement regarding faculty business to a faculty committee.

## Justification

Current R&P limits bringing faulty business to the attention of a faculty committee to voting members of the faculty which can be interpreted to be university faculty (tenured and tenure track) only. This change makes it clear that any faculty member including term faculty (research, teaching, and professors of practice) may bring faculty business to the attention of a faculty committee.
